**TEMPORARY CLOSURE B4058 OLD TOWN (WOTTON-UNDER-EDGE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT**

Gloucestershire County Council has made an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) to temporarily close part of the B4058 Old Town from just before the property known as number 4 Old Town to just after the property known as number 1 Church Street for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

The reason for the closure is to undertake CCTV investigations of the sewers using no dig methods via existing manholes.

The road is expected to be closed from 09:00 on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2020 until 17:00 on the 20<sup>th</sup> January 2020 or until the works have been completed. **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER B4058 OLD TOWN**  
**(WOTTON-UNDER-EDGE TOWN) (STROUD DISTRICT)**  
**ORDER 2019**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for B4058 Old Town from just before the property known as number 4 Old Town to just after the property known as number 1 Church Street for a distance of approximately 40 metres ("the Road") is satisfied that use of the Road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road;
2. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road;
3. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road;
4. The Road falls in Wotton-under-Edge Town in the Stroud District and in the County of Gloucestershire;
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January Two Thousand and Twenty and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months;
6. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Order B4058 Old Town (Wotton-Under-Edge Town) (Stroud District) Order 2019".
7. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
