**TEMPORARY CLOSURE 401502 HILL MILL LANE
(WOTTON-UNDER-EDGE TOWN AND OZLEWORTH PARISH)
COTSWOLD DISTRICT**

Gloucestershire County Council has made an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) to temporarily close part of the 401502 Hill Mill Lane from its junction with C284 Wortley Road to its junction with 401502 Blacksmith Hill for a distance of approximately 1.8 kilometres.

The reason for the closure is during the installation of Gigaclear rural fibre the road will be too narrow for cars to pass safely.

401502 HILL MILL LANE
(WOTTON-UNDER-EDGE TOWN AND OZLEWORTH PARISH) COTSWOLD DISTRICT
ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for 401502 Hill Mill Lane from its junction with C284 Wortley Road to its junction with 401502 Blacksmith Hill for a distance of approximately 1.8 kilometres ("the Road") is satisfied that use of the Road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road;
2. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Road;
3. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road;
4. The Road falls in Wotton-Under-Edge Town and Ozleworth Parish in the Cotswold District and in the County of Gloucestershire;
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of February Two Thousand and Twenty and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months;
6. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Order 401502 Hill Mill Lane (Wotton-Under-Edge Town and Ozleworth Parish) Cotswold District Order 2020".
7. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
